In order for most families to be able to hear from all their children's teachers, the DK, K, and 1st grade teachers will be presenting from 7:00-7:30 and the 2nd-6th grade teachers will present from 7:30-8:00.

Dear Families,

We are still praying for all of you and thanking you for the way you have reached out to so many during this time of rescue and recovery. We have an incredible opportunity to help another school in our community. The Woods Private School was flooded and they can't get back into their building for at least another 6 weeks. We are able to open our doors and give them some temporary classrooms at Windwood and Kardia.

This is what's happening:

The 1st-5th grades of the Woods School will have their car line at the front of the campus between 8:15 and 8:30. They will combine classes and use the classrooms in our adult building.

The Woods kindergarten classes will use our car line from 8:15-8:30 and they will have their classrooms in the journey room.

The 2 pre-school classes will have their classes in one of our portables. Their school day is from 9:00-1:00 and the parents will bring them in and take them out.

Our Kardia kids will use our regular carline from 8:30-8:45 and they will walk around the building to the café and gym area.

We will have devotions in the Summit, which is our high school area on Sundays. The Summit is in the same building as the gym. Our Bible, music and art will take place there as well.

We will have three lunch times and our lunch will remain the same from 11:45-12:15 with recess following. The Woods children will have a lunch at 11:10-11:40 and recess after that and then the older Woods children will have recess at 11:45 and eat after our lunch time at 12:20.

Then after school pick up will be in the same designated areas. The Woods students end their day at 3:00. Our pick up will be out the journey room door as always at the back of the campus.

Before and After care for our children will be the same.

Before and After care for the Woods will be in the café area and our library for the littler ones.

The only class we are combining is our DK and Kindergarten and both Miss Lyda and Mrs. G will be with them and their classwork will go on just in a little different manner for a short period of time. The total number of students will be 13 in that class. During the day if they have a need to break out into smaller groups they can use the library or our old computer room where Becky's office is. We are confident Miss Lyda and Mrs. G will make this a smooth and may be even extra exciting time for our youngest students.

The administration area for the Woods will be in the adult building near those classrooms and in the Summit in the former office of the youth director who moved into the adult building.

Isn't it cool how God directed us into moving our start time and ending time to make it so easy to stagger the car lines. He was getting us ready to serve. God is always in control. Our Senior Pastor said that God is more concerned about our character than our circumstances and a crisis like hurricane Harvey brings out the character in us. Thank you for having a strong, caring character. We will be talking to the students about the changes, but wanted them to come in and feel comfortable, then slowly make the changes. The Woods will not begin school with us until Monday, September 11th. Please pray for this school and their families.

The director, Donna Boase and her staff are so appreciative. If you have any questions don't hesitate to ask us! Thank you for partnering with us to help others in our community. You're the best families and your kids – they are the greatest. It was such a joy to see them back on campus this week!
